أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ الْعَظِيمِ، وَبِوَجْهِهِ الْكَرِيمِ، وَ سُلْطَانِهِ
الْقَدِيمِ، مِنْ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ، بِسْمِ اللَّهِ، وَ الصَّلَاةُ وَ
السَّلَامُ عَلَى رَسُولِ اللَّهِ، اللَّهُمَّ افْتَحْ لِي أَبْوَابَ
رَحْمَتِكَ.

“A’oodthu billaahil-‘adheem, wa bi-wajihil-
kareem, wa sultaanihil-qadeem, minash-
shaytaanir-rajeem, bismillaah[i], wassalaatu
wassalaamu ‘alaa rasoolillaah[i], allaahum-
maftah lee ‘abwaaba rahmatik[a].”

(I take refuge with Allah, The Supreme, and with His Noble Face, and His eternal authority from the accursed devil.¹ In the name of Allah, and prayers¹ and peace be upon the Messenger of Allah.¹ O Allah, open the gates of Your mercy for me.)
